The GAF (Guildford Action for Families) works alongside families in crisis referred to us by local agencies as well as self referral, we assist them in overcoming their challenges and to have a family unit where all can grow in a safe and nurturing environment. Much of our work takes place within the family home, and it is by being there that we can understand the real difficulties they face and support them to regain control over their lives. We work with them through outreach and community drop-in sessions to increase self esteem and confidence.

The Day Service supports those who are experiencing issues around homelessness as well as those on low incomes. There are many issues that visitors to the project face, which may include housing, debt, mental health challenges, isolation, relationship breakdown, employment, effects of crime and substance misuse.

Clients within the Day Service can;

- Relax in a warm, welcoming and friendly environment
- Use of shower and laundry facilities.
- Receive free clean clothing
- Get advice and advocacy on a range of issues including housing, debt and welfare benefits, which includes a support plan tailored for every individual.
- Have access to signposting to specialist agencies
- Attend primary healthcare sessions with the Doctor, who attends during the week.
- Take part in a number of activities including football, fishing, arts & crafts, cookery, swimming and drama.
- Receive affordable Food.

The Service is open from 9.30 am to 4.00 pm Monday to Friday. Rough Sleeper Access is from 8.00am till 9.30am, where those without accommodation can have a hot drink and contact emergency night shelters as well as getting advice from the project workers.

The Service sees on average over 425 different individuals in any given year.
