<b>Summary</b> This report updates Parish Councillors on issues relating to the Tree Survey commissioned by the Parish Council.	
<p>Trees on Westmore and Tatsfield Greens are surveyed and maintained by Tandridge District Council. This survey was commissioned to survey trees on the other parcels of Parish land.</p> <p>The tree survey is a 'negative survey' in that only trees requiring works were recorded and plotted.</p> <p>The survey registered these works at three levels of priority and detailed the recommended actions. The number 1 priority work should be carried out as soon as possible.</p> <p>Allotment site - 4 trees were identified as level 1 and the landowner has been fully informed as the Parish Council is the leaseholder at this site and does not have authority to work on the trees.</p> <p>The only other priority 1 work is to lift the crown of a common hawthorn to a height of 3 metres at the Shaw Road Triangle.</p> <p>Members of the Green Spaces Committee have already volunteered to look at these parcels of Parish woodland to identify any other obvious problems that have resulted from recent wet and windy weather.</p> <p>I propose that the Green Spaces Committee be asked to develop an action plan to address the works raised by the survey and notify us of the expected costs involved.</p>
